Please have the following item drafted for possible inclusion in the Governor's 2003-05 biennial budget bill:

Consolidation Incentive Program. Delete the shared revenue consolidation incentive program created by Act 109. Under current law, beginning in CY04, municipalities can gain incentive payments based on estimated savings generated by consolidation efforts. Funding for the payments is obtained by skimming the necessary amount, up to \$45 million, from payments under the shared revenue "county and municipal aid account". This draft will delete this new program before it begins.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Under current law, beginning in 2004, counties and municipalities that agree to consolidate county or municipal services are eligible to receive consolidation incentive payments equal to 75% of the amount that the counties or municipalities save as a result of consolidating services. This bill eliminates consolidation incentive payments.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 20.835 (1) (db) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 20.835 (1) (db) *County and municipal aid account.* Beginning in 2004, a sum
4 sufficient to make payments to counties, towns, villages, and cities under ss. s.

5 municipality or county under ss. 79.03, 79.035, ~~79.036~~, 79.04, 79.05, 79.058, and
6 79.06.
