

Please have the following item drafted for possible inclusion in the 2003-05 biennial budget bill:

Choice & Charter Payments – K12 education aids. Beginning in FY04, set the annual increase in the per pupil payments under the Milwaukee Choice program at the prior year's payment multiplied by the percent increase in the s.20.255(2)(ac) general school aids appropriation over the prior year. Set the annual increase in the per pupil payments under the Milwaukee Charter program equal to the per pupil dollar increase in the Choice program. Specify that the annual increase must be zero or positive. Under current law, payment increases for both of these programs are equal to the maximum allowable revenue increase per pupil under the revenue limits.

Example: Assume the increase in the s.20.255(2)(ac) appropriation for general school aids is 2% in FY04 compared to FY03.

FY03 Choice per pupil payment = 5,783
FY03 Charter per pupil payment = 6,952

Per pupil increase for both programs for FY04 would be:
FY03 Choice payment times 2% = 5,783 *2% = \$116.

FY04 payments per pupil
Choice = 5,783 + 116 = 5,899
Charter = 6,952 + 116 = 7,068





Peter -- Here are a few minor changes to draft 1571/1 re: the determination of choice and charter payments.

1. In the analysis portion, drop out mention of UW-Parkside. The Racine charter payment is calculated separately under s.18.40(2)(e). The draft should not, and correctly does not, impact the Racine charter payments.
- ✓ 2. Retain the current law provision that states that if a choice school's cost per pupil is lower than the amount paid in the prior year plus the determined increase, the state pays the cost per pupil.
- ✓ 3. Clarify that the intention of the draft is to not allow the per pupil amount to decrease compared to the prior year, but the total payment to a charter or choice school may decrease if fewer pupils are enrolled. This may be done by adding "per pupil" after "The amount" on page 2, line 8 and adding "per pupil under this paragraph" after "payment" on page 3, line 3.
4. During reconciliation, this draft must be modified so that the percent increase in general school aid is calculated using the sum of s.20.255(2)(ac) and the newly created s.20.255(2)(r). This new appropriation uses transportation fund dollars for school equalization aid and is created in draft 1599 that Lonnie has written.
