**Description:**

Consolidate the state owned office rent appropriations with the private facility rent increases appropriations. The chapter 20 language of each private facility rental increase appropriation should be modified to include the language/intent of the state owned office rent supplement appropriations. The identified appropriations are listed below.

20.865 (2)(ag) should be merged into 20.865 (2)(a)	GPR Space supplements
20.865 (2)(gg) should be merged into 20.865 (2)(g)	PR Space supplements
20.865 (2)(qg) should be merged into 20.865 (2)(q)	SEG Space supplements

The intent of this request is to consolidate the private and lease appropriations into one appropriation to allow for flexibility in allocating funds. It is anticipated that agency consolidations and reorganizations will occur during the 03-05 biennium that could change the mix of private and state-owned space.
