**R.J.:** 

Thanks for the information.

As I mentioned in my phone message, I've talked to a few people around here and I think I was a bit confused about drafting language increasing and decreasing positions. Actually, I only need to draft language if you are transferring a particular incumbent holding a position. In that case I must also transfer the position. In all other cases, s. 16.505 (1) permits the legislature "by law or in budget determinations," to create or abolish positions.

So, the question is: for the 2.0 positions in UW and the 2.0 positions in DOA, are you transferring incumbents from HEAB to fill these positions? If so, I need to describe in a position decrease provision the 4.0 positions in HEAB those incumbents are holding and make a corresponding increase in DOA and UW. If you are not transferring incumbents, then no language is necessary in the budget bill.

On the issue of what to do with the appropriations in s. 20.235 (2), there are numerous appropriations under that subsection in addition to pars. (aa), (ga), and (qb). Those other appropriations are (bb), (bc), (bd), (gb), (ja), (ja), (n), and (qa). What do you want done with these appropriations? Options include renumbering them into new s. 20.285 (7) or elsewhere in s. 20.285 or repealing them if they have outlived their usefulness.

If you repeal the continuing appropriations ((gb), (ia), lja), (n), and (qa)), there may be an unencumbered balance left in the appropriation, which under s. 20.002 (3m) lapses to the fund from which it came unless the bill specifies otherwise. Thus, if you want the unencumbered balance to go somewhere else, e.g., to another appropriation, the bill must so specify.

- 1. What appropriations fund the positions to be abolished? I need to know because the position decrease provision will read something like "The autorized FTE positions for HEAB, funded from the appropriation under s. 20.235 (\*) (\*), are decreased by \*.\* (GPR) (FED) (PR) positions . . . ".
- 2. HEAB has numerous appropriations under s. 20.235 (1) and (2). I had envisioned that those appropriations would be renumbered into a new program under s. 20.285, which is the appropriation to the board of regents, e.g., 20.285 (7). Is that your understanding? One more question: In certain provision in s. 39.41 relating to academic excellence scholarships, the executive secretary of HEAB is directed to take certain actions. When the program is moved to the board of regents who should take such actions? The president? The secretary? Or should the statutes simply say the board?

Under current law, (HEAB) administers various student financial aid programs for state residents attending institutions of higher education, including Wisconsin higher education grants, talent incentive grants, tuition grants, handicapped student grants, Indian student assistance grants, minority undergraduate retention grants, teacher education loans, minority teacher loans, health education loans, nursing student loans, and academic excellence scholarships. HEAB also administers contracts with the Medical College of Wisconsin and the Marquette University Dental School under which a per capita amount is paid to those institutions for each state resident enrolled at those institutions and a tuition reciprocity agreement with the state of Minnesota. This bill, effective on January 1, 2004, eliminates HEAB and the executive secretary and deputy executive secretary positions in HEAB and transfers the duties of HEAB to the board of regents of the Wisconsin System.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
