Transfer the Wisconsin Conservation Corps program under s.20.445(6) ~~and~~ to the Department of Workforce Development under s.20.445(1). Specifically:

1. Eliminate requirement for a board and executive director and transfer responsibility for final approval of grant distribution to the secretary of the department.

2. Make the following changes to the appropriation structure:

- ✓ Create an appropriation under s.20.445(1) to administer the youth employment program conservation grants and transfer \$130,000 in authority from the appropriation under s.20.445(6)(y). RA (y); (1)(y)

5. Require the secretary of administration to issue grants to community based organizations that: At risk of what?

- Serve at-risk youth between the ages of 14 and 21
- Pay participants in the program at least minimum wage
- Offer educational and life skills training

- Improve the employment skills of participants in the program.

I have received your drafting instructions relating to transferring portions of the WCC Program to DWD.

With respect to the appropriations, s. 20.445 (6) (u) and (y) are annual appropriations (The amounts in the schedule . . .), so you will handle that at your end when you prepare the appropriation schedule.

The remaining appropriations that are going to be repealed are continuing ("All moneys received . . ."). Those appropriations may have unencumbered balances at the end of FY 2002-03. Do you want to transfer any of those unencumbered balances to any particular appropriation in s. 20.445 (1) or do you wish those balances to simply lapse to the general fund under s. 20.002 (3m)? If you want them to lapse we don't have to do anything. If you want to transfer them, you will have to tell me what appropriation balances you want transferred to where.

EMPLOYMENT

Under current law, the Wisconsin Conservation Corps (WCC) employs young adults to work on conservation and human services activities. The WCC Program is administered by the WCC Board, which may delegate its administrative responsibilities to the executive secretary of the board. This bill eliminates the WCC, the WCC board, and the position of executive secretary of the WCC board and, instead, requires DWD to provide grants to community-based nonprofit organizations for the provision of youth employment projects that provide employment for youths 14 years of age or over, but less than 21 years of age, in all regions of this state; conserve, develop, enhance, or maintain the natural resources of this state; promote the social well-being of children, the elderly, persons with disabilities, and persons with low incomes; encourage and develop employment and life skills, discipline, and cooperation in project participants by providing meaningful work experiences and training and education opportunities for those participants; and pay not less than the minimum wage.



Education vouchers aren't expected to be part of the new program and it appears that the language under s.106.217 would allow for the payment of outstanding WCC vouchers. *But you need \$ to pay voucher. \$ must come from approp.*

ok 2. s.106.215(2): It would be nice if the language for this section could be changed to something along the lines of, "...designed to promote (a) and one or more of (b),(c) or (d). - See (1m)

(OK) 3. s.106.215(1m): The struck language ("may be utilized for any project approved by the board regardless of whether the project consists of conservation activities) should be retained, with "board" being changed to "department."

4. non-statutory language: we're having problems over here actually identifying the individual to transfer to DWD to run the program. Would it be possible to require an MOU between DWD and the Department of Commerce to ensure the smooth continued operation of the Operation Fresh Start program?

On redraft I will delete the provisions relating to prevailing wage. The provisions relating to paper review and right to sue are already in the draft.

The operative language relating to paper review are the words "which review shall be based solely on the department's record of the complaint." That language distinguishes paper review from a hearing.

As for right to sue, the draft permits an employee to sue at any time before the running of the statute of limitations, including after a finding of no probable cause.

Josh:

1. It would be problematic to eliminate "education vouchers" from s. 20.445 (1) (u). Although, as you correctly point out, s. 106.217 *authorizes* payment of education vouchers, it does not *fund* those vouchers. Accordingly, we need to keep an appropriation on the books to pay for those vouchers until the department is not longer liable to pay for those vouchers. Because those vouchers are good for four years, the delayed repeal of s. 106. 217 and amendment of 20.445 (1) (u) to remove the reference to vouchers take effect 48 months after the general effective date of the budget.
2. Section 106.215 (2) applies to the overall *guidelines*, not to any particular *project*. Accordingly, the redraft will amend s. 106.215 (1m) to require that the individual *projects* meet the objectives of providing employment, providing personal development, and paying the minimum wage and of providing either a conservation activity or a human services activity, or both.
3. The redraft will restore the stricken language of s. 106.215 (1m).
4. A typical format that we use when it is undecided exactly which employees to transfer is to provide that the secretary of administration will designate the employees for transfer and that if either department is dissatisfied with the designation, that department may appeal to the joint committee on finance.

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
