

Please combine various appropriations and funding under s.20.292(1) and create an appropriation to fund grants to expand health care programs at technical college districts. Specifically, this request is to:

1. *Combine the appropriations and authority under s.20.292(1)(cm) and s.20.292(1)(er) in a new appropriation and transfer \$1,000,000 from the appropriation under s.20.292(1)(dc) to that appropriation in FY05.* (combine schedule)
2. *Repeal statutory language regarding the Capacity grant program and the Additional course section grant program.* 38.04 (19)

3. *Give the board authority to issue grants to local technical college districts from the new appropriation to expand health care programs.*

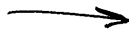


SEC. RP. W. 292 (1) (cm)

Section #. 38.28 (1m) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

38.28 (1m) (a) 1. "District aidable cost" means the annual cost of operating a technical college district, including debt service charges for district bonds and promissory notes for building programs or capital equipment, but excluding all expenditures relating to auxiliary enterprises and community service programs, all expenditures funded by or reimbursed with federal revenues, all receipts under sub. (6) and ss. 38.12 (9), 38.14 (3) and (9), 118.15 (2) (a), 118.55 (7r), and 146.55 (5), all receipts from grants awarded under ss. 38.04 (8), ~~(19)~~, (20), <sup>(28)</sup> and (31), 38.14 (11), 38.26, 38.27, ~~38.31~~, 38.33, and 38.38, all fees collected under s. 38.24, and driver education and chauffeur training aids.
