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

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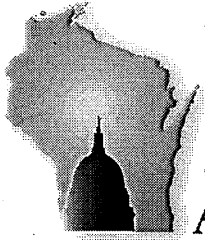

**Title:** Restructuring of human services system

**Purpose of Draft:** The draft will give the DHFS Secretary the authority to establish a commission to investigate ways to restructure the human and social services delivery systems in the state. The secretary would be directed to submit a report to the Governor and Legislature. See the attachment for suggested, nonstatutory language.

**Priority:** Low.

SESSION LAW LANGUAGE – DHFS  
Redesign of the Human/Social Services Funding System

By October 1, 2004, the secretary of the department of health and family services shall submit a report and recommendations to the Governor and Legislature to restructure the system under which publicly-run human/social services programs are funded in the state of Wisconsin. The secretary shall create an advisory committee consisting of consumers, family members of consumers, advocacy organizations, county government and associations, representatives of provider organizations and citizens to participate in developing the recommendations. The report shall consider and make recommendations given these broad goals:

1. Achieving greater equity and consistency of service access across the state, perhaps through a system of statewide eligibility criteria and per-case funding allocations.
2. Affirming a publicly-run system administered at the local level with local flexibility for discretionary spending.
3. Fostering consumer-directed care.
4. Enhancing accountability for effective, efficient delivery of services within available resources.

This bill requires the secretary of health and family services to appoint an advisory committee to consider goals and develop recommendations concerning restructuring the system under which publicly administered human services and social services are funded. The secretary must submit a report of the advisory committee to the legislature and the governor by October 1, 2004.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 9124. Nonstatutory provisions; health and family services.

3 (1) ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES AND SOCIAL SERVICES; REPORT.
