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


Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

✓ VETERANS AND MILITARY AFFAIRS

Under current law, an eligible veteran is reimbursed for his or her tuition and fees upon satisfactory completion of a full-time undergraduate semester in any institution of higher education, school approved for veteran training by the DVA, and proprietary school approved by the Educational Approval Board if the veteran completes the course within 10 years after his or her separation from the armed services. This bill allows the veteran to receive the tuition and fees reimbursement if he or she starts the course within 10 years after his or her separation from the armed services.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 45.25 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 45.25 (2) (c) The individual applies for the tuition and fee reimbursement
2 program for courses ~~completed~~ begun within 10 years after separation from the
3 service.
