

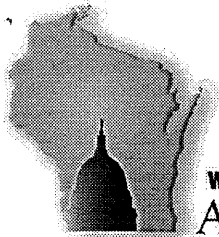

Please draft language to increase the following Department of Justice fees:

s. 20.455 (20(kd) *drug law enforcement and crime laboratories* – increase the fee from \$5 to \$7.

s. 165.82 *criminal history search fee* –

Create a \$5 surcharge if the request is for a paper copy of the criminal history record check. The surcharge should be charged regardless of the type of organization making the request, i.e. non profits, government agencies, and other requesters would all have to pay the \$5 surcharge if they request a paper copy of the criminal history record check.
