Under current law, there is appropriated to the Arts Board general purpose revenues for a grant to the Milwaukee Foundation, Inc., for deposit in the High Point fund and a grant to the city of Stevens Point Arts Council for development of the Portage County Arts Alliance. This bill eliminates those appropriations.

What s. 20.115 (1) (fm) does is create the appropriation and sunset it all in the same provision. We call that "in-text applicability dates." It is an alternative to a separate bill section repealing that provision at a later date. So, I would think it would be good housekeeping to repeal s. 20.115 (1) (fm) since, by its own language, it does not apply after June 30, 2000, anyway.
