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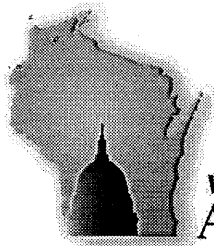

**Subject:** Office of Justice Assistance (OJA) 2003-05 Biennial Budget Request  
Statutory Language Drafts

I am forwarding statutory language changes related to the OJA that Governor Doyle proposes to include in the budget.

Under s. 20.505(6)(m), the OJA is authorized to receive money from the federal government for state agency operations for justice assistance to carry out the purpose for which the money is received. Under s. 20.505(6)(p), the OJA is authorized to receive money from the federal government for project grants to improve the administration of criminal justice.

The Governor proposed to designate the OJA as the lead agency on homeland security and as such to administer all federal funding received for this purpose. Because the aforementioned statutes are not board enough for the Governor's proposed mandate, please draft the language that creates a new, continuing appropriation, with a zero dollar balance, and accomplishes this change.
