HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

HEALTH

Under current law, DHFS must collect, analyze, and disseminate claims information and other health care information, as adjusted for case mix and severity, from health care providers. DHFS may waive the requirement for a health care provider who presents evidence to DHFS that the requirement is burdensome.

This bill eliminates the requirement that DHFS collect, analyze, and disseminate claims information and other health care information from health care providers.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 153.05 (8) of the statutes is repealed.

3 SECTION 2. 153.05 (13) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 153.05 (13) The department may waive the requirement under sub. (1), ~~(5) or~~
2 ~~(8)~~ [↓] or (5) for a health care provider, who requests the waiver and presents evidence to the
3 department that the requirement under sub. (1), ~~(5) or (8)~~ [↓] or (5) is burdensome, under
4 standards established by the department by rule. The department shall develop a
5 form for use by a health care provider in submitting a request under this subsection.
