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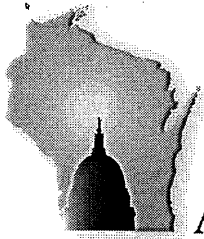



Budget Office Request Title:

Adjust expenditure limit for s. 20.370(1)(fe).

Request Description:

Note: this issue has been brought to the attention of Mary Gibson-Glass and Robin Kite. They will address it in the next version of the bill. I do not know if they plan to create a separate draft number.

Change the expenditure limit in s. 20.370(1)(fe)1., Endangered resources -- general fund, to equal \$312,200 in FY04 and \$364,000 in FY05. (Decision items relating to ongoing 13.10 supplements and expenditure reductions modify the ch. 20 schedule for this appropriation. Because it is sum sufficient, a statutory cap is necessary to ensure that the department does not expend more than is in the schedule.)

Under current law, from the general fund (the Department of Natural Resources (DNRO) is appropriated for the endangered species program a matching amount, not to exceed \$500,000 in each fiscal year, that equals the sum of the amount of donations and bequests received for the program and the amount that taxpayers designate on their state income tax returns as voluntary payments for the program. Under current law, the \$500,000 maximum is decreased to \$482,500 for fiscal year 2001-02 and to \$475,000 for fiscal year 2002-03. Under this bill, the \$500,000 maximum is decreased to \$312,200 for fiscal year 2003-04 and to \$364,000 for fiscal year 2004-05.
