Under current law, from the general fund the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is appropriated for the endangered species program a matching amount, not to exceed \$500,000 in each fiscal year, that equals the sum of the amount of donations and bequests received for the program and the amount that taxpayers designate on their state income tax returns as voluntary payments for the program. Under current law, the \$500,000 maximum is decreased to \$482,500 for fiscal year 2001–02 and to \$475,000 for fiscal year 2002–03. Under this bill, the \$500,000 maximum is decreased to \$312,200 for fiscal year 2003–04 and to \$364,000 for fiscal year 2004–05.
