Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, the secretaries of commerce and administration, or their designees, serve on the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority, along with other designated members. This bill adds the secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection, or his or her designee, to the authority.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 234.02 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

234.02 (1) There is created a public body corporate and politic to be known as the "Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority." The members of the authority shall be the secretary of commerce or his or her designee, the secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection or his or her designee, and the secretary of administration or his or her designee, and 6 public members nominated by the

governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed, for staggered 4—year terms commencing on the dates their predecessors' terms expire. In addition, one senator of each party and one representative to the assembly of each party appointed as are the members of standing committees in their respective houses shall serve as members of the authority. A member of the authority shall receive no compensation for services but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses, including travel expenses, incurred in the discharge of duties. Subject to the bylaws of the authority respecting resignations, each member shall hold office until a successor has been appointed and has qualified. A certificate of appointment or reappointment of any member shall be filed with the authority and the certificate shall be conclusive evidence of the due and proper appointment.
