Outpatient Competency Examinations (Paper #422)

Motion:

Move to delete the Governor's provision that would limit DHFS' responsibility for conducting inpatient examinations and outpatient examinations to defendants in jail or in a locked unit of a facility.

Note:

A competency examination may be conducted outside of a jail or locked facility in cases where an individual is out on bail, parole, or probation. Under current law, the state supports the costs of these examinations. The Governor's proposal would transfer responsibility for competency examinations conducted outside of a jail or locked facility to counties. This motion would delete this provision from the bill.
