Well-Woman Program and Multiple Sclerosis Education

Motion:

Move to require DHFS to expend \$60,000 GPR annually from the amounts budgeted for the well-woman program (\$2,188,200 GPR annually) to conduct multiple sclerosis screening as part of screenings conducted by the well-woman program

Note:

Under current law, the well-woman program is budgeted \$2,188,200 GPR annually. From these funds, the Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) provides reimbursement for health care screenings, referrals, follow-ups, and patient education provided to low-income, underinsured, and uninsured women.

Within the amounts budgeted for the program, DHFS is required to provide: (a) breast cancer screening services; (b) media announcements and educational materials; (c) breast cancer screenings using mobile mammography vans; (d) specialized training for rural colposcopic examinations and activities; (e) health care screening, referral, follow-up, and patient education; (f) a women's health campaign; (g) osteoporosis prevention and education; and (h) multiple sclerosis education. However, if the projected costs of conducting these activities exceeds the amount budgeted, DHFS must modify services and reimbursement accordingly to not exceed its budget authority.

This motion would require DHFS to expend \$60,000 GPR annually from the funding for the well-woman program to support multiple sclerosis screening, notwithstanding a determination that services or reimbursement should be modified because the projected costs exceed the appropriated amounts. If necessary, DHFS would reduce funding or services in other areas to ensure that the multiple sclerosis screenings would receive \$60,000 GPR annually.
