Move to exempt individuals with hemophilia from the provision in the bill that would require all individuals to apply to other health care programs, as specified by DHFS, for which he or she may reasonably be eligible, before receiving assistance under the hemophilia home care program of the Wisconsin chronic disease program

Note:

SB 44 would permit an individual to receive assistance under the disease aids program only after he or she first applied for benefits under all other health care coverage programs specified by DHFS rule for which the person reasonably may be eligible. The bill would direct DHFS to promulgate rules that specify these other programs, but the rules would have to include medical assistance, BadgerCare and SeniorCare.

This motion would exempt individuals with hemophilia from this requirement.

2. I did not remove the reference to s. 49.687 (1m) (b) from s. 49.685 (6) (b) in the bill because, presumably, a person might have coverage under one of those programs even if he or she is not required to apply for any of those programs first.
