Joint Finance took action on several issues today which will require drafting. Please draft the following items. I will fax motions to you after I send this.

Motion 121 (Paper 573) - Consolidated Brownfields Grant Program. This is similar to (but not the same as current law). Rob, I believe this is the only item in this email you would be involved in. Ron or I can answer questions you might have.

Motion 513 (Papers 570 and 571) - Agrichemical Management and Environmental Fund Revenues. Chris can answer your agchem-related questions. I can answer your environmental fund questions.

* Motion 122 (Paper 572) - Vehicle fee. A lot of this is chapter 20 reductions, but the key drafting is no increase above \$9, and extend the sunset to December 31, 2005.

Paper 574 - Environmental repair bonding, Alternative 3, no increase in bonding.

Motion 118 (Paper 575) - Increase transfer from recycling fund to general fund (be careful here as LRB 105/1 also has a separate increase in the transfer from the recycling fund).

Paper 576 - Alternative 1, Air staff no draft needed.

Paper 577 Air Asbestos - Alternative A1 (no draft needed), B6 (draft needed) and C1 (no draft needed).

**Vehicle Environmental Impact Fee
[LFB Paper #572]**

Motion:

Move to delete the fee increase and retain the current \$9 vehicle environmental impact fee. Extend the December 31, 2003, sunset of the fee, to December 31, 2005. Estimated fee revenue would be \$6,700,000 in 2003-04 (a decrease of \$1,010,000 from the bill) and \$13,400,000 in 2004-05 (a decrease of \$3,110,000 from the bill). In addition, decrease \$3,656,500 SEG (26.5% decrease) in all appropriations from the environmental management account in 2004-05, other than for the brownfields grant program, household hazardous waste program, debt service and UW Systems environmental education, and delete 25.03 SEG positions, as follows: (1) reduce the DNR Air and Waste Division general operations appropriation by \$1,025,700 SEG and 13.26 SEG positions; (2) reduce the Enforcement and Science Division general operations appropriation by \$315,800 SEG and 2.92 SEG positions; (3) reduce the Water Division general operations appropriation by \$614,900 SEG and 5.83 SEG positions; (4) reduce the Administration and Technology Division general operations appropriation by \$419,100 SEG; (5) reduce the Customer Assistance and External Relations Division general operations appropriation by \$153,600 SEG and 2.10 SEG positions; (6) reduce the DNR state-funded response cleanup appropriation by \$880,500 SEG; (7) reduce the DNR well compensation grant appropriation by \$106,000 SEG; (8) reduce the DNR groundwater management appropriation by \$33,100 SEG; (9) reduce the Department of Health and Family Services groundwater and air quality standards appropriation by \$105,000 SEG and 0.93 SEG position; and (10) reduce the Department of Military Affairs emergency response training appropriation by \$2,800 SEG.

Note:

This is the same as Alternative A3a to LFB Budget Paper #572, except that no reductions would be made from the brownfields grant or household hazardous waste appropriations, and all of the expenditure reductions would be made in the other appropriations listed in Alternative A3a. It would also extend the sunset of the vehicle fee by two years to December 31, 2005.
