Move to eliminate the requirement that DNR issue a backtag to individuals purchasing a resident or non-resident deer hunting license.

Note:

Under the motion, some savings to the fish and wildlife account (approximately \$56,000 annually) would be realized due to reduced paper and printing costs from the elimination of the production of backtags. This would be partially offset by revenues lost from the sale of reserved backtag numbers, estimated at \$15,400 annually.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Currently, a person who hunts deer, elk, or bear must wear a back tag issued by the Department of Natural Resources, in addition to obtaining a hunting license and a deer, elk, or bear tag. This bill eliminates the requirement that a hunter wear a back tag.
