Junior Combination Licenses

Motion:

Move to create a junior conservation patron license and a junior sportsmen license. Specify that the annual licenses would have the same privileges as the existing conservation patron and sportsmen licenses, but restrict the sale of these licenses to individuals who are at least 12 years old but no more than 17 years old at the time that the license is purchased. Specify that the fee for the junior conservation patron license would be \$75 annually, and the fee for the junior sportsmen license would be \$35 annually. Further, specify that the junior combination licenses would be available to residents and nonresidents for the same fee.

TO 2003 SENATE BILL 44

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

The instructions for this draft were to create a junior conservation patron license and a junior sports license for 12 to 17-year-olds. The motion on which the draft is based states that the fees for these junior licenses are to be reduced from the fees charged for the regular conservation patron licenses and sports licenses.

Because the privileges of the junior licenses will be exactly the same as the privileges of the current conservation patron and sports licenses, I did not create two new licenses. Instead, the draft specifies a reduced fee for conservation patron and sports licenses issued to 12 to 17-year-olds. This approach is consistent with the way in which small game licenses are issued to 12 to 17-year-olds under s. 29.563 (2) (a) 4 stats.

Under current law, an issuing fee and a wildlife damage surcharge are assessed for various fish and game approvals. The issuing fee under current law for conservation patron and sports licenses is 75 cents. The wildlife damage surcharge is \$1 for sports licenses and \$2 for conservation patron licenses. The draft provides that these fees and surcharges also apply to the "junior" licenses. Accordingly, the fees specified in this draft are lower than the fees specified in the motion to reflect the fact that, after the issuing fees and relevant wildlife damage surcharges are assessed, the fees will total the amounts stated in the motion.
