



Invasive Species Management

Motion:

Move to earmark \$250,000 in 2003-04 and \$500,000 in 2004-05 from recreational boating project aids to be awarded for projects related to the prevention or control of aquatic invasive species, and for education and inspection programs at boat landings.

Note:

Under the bill, recreational boating project aids are funded at \$4,547,000 annually from the water resources account of the conservation fund. The local match requirement under the program is generally 40 to 50% of project costs. The Waterways Commission currently awards about \$50,000 annually for this purpose (primarily related to Eurasian water milfoil control).
