Under Senate Bill 44, the crime laboratories and drug law enforcement assessment is increased from \$5 to \$7. Under the bill, it is estimated that this fee increase would generate additional revenues of \$1,267,500 in 2003-04 and \$1,690,000 in 2004-05, but these additional revenues are incorrectly identified as GPR-Earned under the bill.
