Motion:

Move to approve Alternative 1. In addition, transfer \$51,600 and 1.4 conservation warden positions in 2004-05 from GPR to recycling fund SEG.

law enforcement activities

motorboat gas tax funding

Note:

The motion would transfer \$132,700 and 2.2 conservation warden positions annually from GPR to water resources account SEG, and \$51,600 and 1.4 conservation warden positions in 2004-05 from GPR to recycling fund SEG.

Under the bill, as modified by Joint Committee on Finance actions prior to May 16, 2003, the recycling fund would have an estimated June 30, 2005, balance of \$51,600. The motion would utilize that balance to convert 1.4 conservation wardens and \$51,600 of the \$84,400 in annual funding for the positions from GPR to recycling fund SEG beginning in 2004-05.

[Change to Bill: - \$317,000 GPR and - 3.6 GPR positions, \$51,600 recycling fund SEG and 1.4 SEG positions, \$265,400 water resources account SEG and 2.2 SEG positions]

Per our conversation, I have two suggestions. First, if you wanted to keep it similar to 20.370 (3)(as):
"The amounts in the schedule from moneys received by the Department under s. 25.29 (1)(c), for state law enforcement operations related to protecting the state's water resources.."

Alternatively, Daryl suggests keeping it even more bare-bones than that: *"Law enforcement -- water resources enforcement. The amounts in the schedule for state law enforcement operations related to protecting the state's water resources."*

He is of the opinion that as long as we leave the "water resources" reference in the appropriation name, we should be able to leave out the reference to the motorboat gas tax. If you think that Daryl's version is sufficient to accomplish our purposes, I would suggest going with that. Clear cut, no messy "conservation fund" references to deal with.

Just as an aside, we talked about the gas tax being referenced in other appropriations. One example is (5)(cs):

*20.370(5)(cs)
(cs) Recreation aids - snowmobile trail areas. As a continuing appropriation, from the snowmobile account in the conservation fund an amount equal to the estimated snowmobile gas tax payment, as determined under s. 25.29 (1) (d), for the purposes specified under s. 350.12 (4) (b).*
