Query: What is the current statutory authority for the conference? Is it s. 44.71 (2) (d), which requires the board to support the development of courses for professional employees licensed by DPI?

If not, I think we should create specific statutory authority for the conference since the conference will now be referenced in a statutory appropriation.

For example:

"16.993 (10) Coordinate an annual conference on educational technology, hosted by the governor, for elementary, secondary, and postsecondary educators and establish a schedule of fees for attending the conference, which fees may not exceed the actual costs incurred in conducting the conference. All fees collected under this subsection shall be credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.505 (4) (hc)."

For an example of a similar provision see ss. 20.445 (7) (ga) and 106.12 (4) relating to the Governor's Work-Based Learning Board.
