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

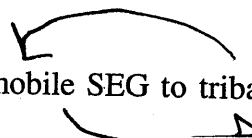

Item #7. Relating to the snowmobile account of the conservation fund, the change to the bill would be to shift \$799,000 and 4.5 positions for the biennium from snowmobile SEG to tribal gaming PR. Further, the motion would shift \$500,000 annually for snowmobile trail aids from SEG to tribal gaming PR to balance snowmobile account expenditures with anticipated revenues. In sum, compared to the bill, \$1.8 million would be shifted from snowmobile SEG to tribal gaming PR for the biennium.

NATURAL RESOURCES

RECREATION

Under current law, DNR may provide from the conservation fund enforcement aids to counties for the purpose of enforcing laws relating to snowmobiling. This bill creates a program revenue-service appropriation from the general fund that is funded by certain moneys received by the state pursuant to Indian gaming compacts. The bill permits DNR to also provide to counties these enforcement aids amounts from this program revenue-service appropriation.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

On or before June 1, a county shall file with the department on forms prescribed by the department a detailed statement of the costs incurred by the county in the enforcement of this chapter during the preceding May 1 to April 30. The department shall audit the statements and determine the county's net costs for enforcement of this chapter. The department shall compute the state aids on the basis of 100% of these net costs and shall pay these aids on or before October 1. If the state aids payable to counties
