MINOR POLICY AND TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS

Motion:

Move to adopt the following items.

Administration

1. *Allocation of Certain Low-Income Energy Assistance Funds from Proper DOA Appropriation.* Provide that funding for local government agencies or private non-profit organizations to administer low-income energy assistance funds would be provided from the agency's s. 20.505(1)(n) appropriation rather than from its s. 20.505(1)(mb) appropriation.

2. *Penalty Assessment Match Funding.* Delete \$153,100 PR in 2003-04 and \$86,800 PR in 2004-05 to reflect the net adjustments required for the state and local penalty assessment match funding appropriations under the Office of Justice Assistance, based on all prior Committee actions to date.

Health and Family Services

3. *SeniorCare Copayment Increase.* Specify that the increase in the copayment for brand name drugs purchased under SeniorCare would apply to drugs purchased beginning September 1, 2003, or the first day of the first month after the bill's general effective date, whichever is later, to reflect the savings anticipated under the Committee's previous action.

Natural Resources

4. Renumber the DNR chronic wasting disease management appropriation from conservation aids to wildlife management and repeal an obsolete CWD appropriation.

5. Provide an April 1, 2004, effective date for hunting and fishing fee adjustments.

Veterans Affairs

6. *Conversion of Unclassified Position Fragment.* Convert 0.15 PR unclassified position fragment to 0.15 PR classified position annually to provide 1.0 FTE classified position under

Description of the Error and the Fix

The initiative to transfer the Housing Function from DOA to Commerce retains in DOA program responsibilities for housing-related activities funded from the Weatherization and Low Income Energy Assistance program appropriations. Part of this retention is funding for local governmental agencies or private non-profit organizations administering funds for LIEAP. The language inadvertantly renumbers the wrong appropriation in DOA to receive \$2,900,000 FED in each year for this purpose. The correcting action is to modify s.162 (as it affects s.16.27(3)(d)) of the bill to renumber s. 20.505(7)(m) to s. 20.505(1)(n).
