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

Decrease JFC's appropriation 20.865(4)(a) by \$105,500 in 2003-04 and \$210,900 in 2004-05.

Increase DETF's appropriation 20.515(2)(a) by \$210,900 in 2003-04 and \$210,900 in 2004-05.

That would get you back to the Governor's. That would be a total increase of \$105,400 GPR. Let me know if that was what you were looking for.
