
Dear Senator Breske,

This past Monday I had a most enjoyable meeting with your staff. During our conversation we touched upon the topic of Blackwell's inability to issue high school diplomas. As you are aware, the Blackwell Job Corps Civilian Conservation Center is a unique resource for the State of Wisconsin. It benefits citizens of our state and is funded entirely by federal funds. Our center is located on about 20 acres of the Nicolet National Forest.

We would like to be recognized as an independent and special school district for the sole purpose of issuing high school diplomas to our students who would qualify for them under Department of Public Instruction guidelines. Currently we would only have the ability to do so if we were able to partner with an existing school district and then be recognized as an alternative high school for that district. We seek no ability to raise funds through any type of taxation since we are funded by the Department of Labor under the auspices of the Workforce Investment Act. It seems that the only way that Blackwell could acquire the ability to issue diplomas would be through legislation recognizing our center as a unique entity invested with that power. This would enable us to provide our students with another option that could enable them to earn a credible academic credential.

Any help that you may provide on this issue will be greatly appreciated. In addition, if you or your staff are in the area of our center, please do visit us. If you or your staff arrange a time in advance, I would be delighted to talk to you here on center. We always enjoy having you visit us.

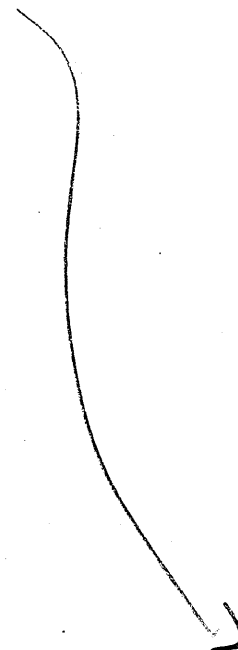
