Peter:

Senator Erpenbach, on behalf of Senate Democrats, would like to have several amendments to the JFC sub to SB 44 drafted pertaining to K-12 education. I have detailed the contents of the amendments below.

Senate Democrats will caucus on the budget this Friday, June 13 at 8:30 AM. They have requested that amendments be available for the caucus at that time, if at all possible.

The drafting request is listed below:

- 1. Eliminate several provisions of JFC action pertaining to school choice. Remove language of AB 259, AB 260 and AB 261 from JFC sub. Restore Governor's position and funding levels for school choice. Restore 400 pupil limit for enrollment at charter school in Racine. ~~Restore MPS general school aids by \$562,000 in 2003-04 and \$375,000 in 2004-05.~~
- 2. Four year-old kindergarten. Restore Governor's funding levels for K4 over biennium at an amount of \$46 million GPR.
- 3. Eliminate double aid to Racine schools. Eliminate the payments for charter school students to the Racine Unified School Districts.
- 4. Low revenue ceiling 2/3s vote requirement. Eliminate the requirement that a 2/3s vote is required before a school district can increase their low revenue ceiling. (Restore Governor's position. See motion 709, pt 2 for more info)
- 5. SAGE funding. Restore Governor's provision. Continue to make SAGE mandatory in grades K-3.
