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


Right on 49.175(1)(y).

The \$1,404,100 reflects the annual amount that was provided under 1999 Act 9. I am not sure why fiscal years were not identified, or why it was never modified to reflect the amounts provided under 2001 Act 16. I agree with you, I think it should be limited to no more than \$750,000 per year.

You would also need to increase 20.445(3)(md) by \$750,000 each year.

Hi, Carri:

Kelly in Wirch's office called to say that they do not want to cut anything to offset the funding for literacy grants after all. For statutory changes, then, I assume that I put 49.175 (1) (y) back in (without the literacy services provided by gov's office) at \$750,000 per fiscal year, but I'm not sure what to do with 49.169 since the amount is not limited by time. Do you know how the amount in 49.169 was intended to work with the amount in 49.175 (1) (y)? I could just limit it to no more than \$750,000 in a fiscal year. What other funding-related changes do I need to make, if any? Thank you!
