## SENATE AMENDMENT 35, TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2003 SENATE BILL 44

June 18, 2003 – Offered by Senators LASSA and MOORE.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 211, line 15: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by
3	\$87,700 to increase funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
4	<b>2.</b> Page 286, line 3: after that line insert:
5	"SECTION 351r. 20.255 (2) (kn) of the statutes is created to read:
6	20.255 (2) (kn) Federal funds transferred from the department of workforce
7	development; after-school care grant program. All moneys transferred from the
8	appropriation account under s. 20.445 (3) (md) for after-school care grants under
9	2003 Wisconsin Act (this act), section 520. No moneys may be encumbered under
10	this paragraph after June 30, 2005.".
11	<b>3.</b> Page 334, line 15: delete " <del>and (kp)</del> " and substitute "and <del>(kp)</del> <u>(kn)</u> ".
12	<b>4.</b> Page 515, line 10: after that line insert:

5	5. Page 1089, line 16: after that line insert:
6	"(3k) AFTER-SCHOOL CARE GRANTS PROGRAM.
7	(a) A school board may apply to the state superintendent of public instruction
8	for a grant to fund an after–school care program for pupils who are eligible to receive
9	temporary assistance for needy families under 42 USC 601 to 619 and who would
10	otherwise be unsupervised by an adult in the afternoon after school.
11	(b) The state superintendent of public instruction shall award grants from the
12	appropriation under section 20.255 (2) (kn) of the statutes, as created by this act, and
13	shall ensure, to the extent feasible, that the grants are evenly distributed among
14	rural, suburban, and urban school districts.
15	(4k) TRANSFER OF FUNDS. On the effective date of this subsection, there is
16	transferred \$87,700 from the appropriation account under section 20.445 (3) (md) of
17	the statutes, as affected by this act, to the appropriation account under section
18	20.255 (2) (kn) of the statutes, as created by this act.".
