1 AN ACT to create 13.94 (1) (br) of the statutes; relating to: a fraud, waste, and
2 mismanagement hot line at the Legislative Audit Bureau.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Legislative Audit Bureau to maintain a toll-free telephone number with voice mail to receive reports of fraud, waste, and mismanagement. For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 13.94 (1) (br) of the statutes is created to read:
4 13.94 (1) (br) Maintain a toll-free telephone number with voice mail at the
5 bureau's office to receive reports of fraud, waste, or mismanagement in state
6 government. The bureau shall relay these reports to the appropriate bureau
7 employee for investigation. The bureau shall publicize the toll-free telephone
8 number on the bureau's website. The bureau shall maintain records that permit the

6 release confidential records maintained by the bureau. /
