2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** an extraordinary session on campaign finance reform, state budget
2 reform, and state government ethics reform.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This is a preliminary draft. An analysis will be provided in a later version.

3 *Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That:*

4 **SECTION 1. Extraordinary session on campaign finance reform, state**
5 **budget reform, and state government ethics reform.** The adoption of and
6 concurrence in this joint resolution by both houses shall constitute the call of the
7 legislature into extraordinary session. The business of the extraordinary session is
8 limited to the adoption of campaign finance reform, state budget reform, and state
9 government ethics reform. Notwithstanding section 1 (4) (a) of 2001 Senate Joint
10 Resolution 1, the legislature may not finally adjourn the extraordinary session until
11 enrolled bills that, collectively, accomplish campaign finance reform, state budget

**SENATE AMENDMENT ,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 SENATE BILL 44**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment[✓] as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1079, line 21: after that line insert:

3 “(5c)[✓] EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ON CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM, STATE BUDGET
4 REFORM, AND STATE GOVERNMENT ETHICS REFORM. The passage of this bill by both houses
5 shall constitute the call of the legislature into extraordinary session. The business
6 of the extraordinary session is limited to the adoption of campaign finance reform,
7 state budget reform, and state government ethics reform. Notwithstanding section
8 1 (4) (a) of 2003 Senate Joint Resolution 1,[✓] the legislature may not finally adjourn
9 the extraordinary session until enrolled bills that, collectively, accomplish campaign
10 finance reform, state budget reform, and state government ethics reform have been
11 passed by both houses. Notwithstanding section 1 (4) (c) of 2003 Senate Joint
12 Resolution 1, the extraordinary session shall immediately reconvene solely for the

1 consideration of executive vetoes or partial vetoes if an enrolled bill passed by both
2 houses during the extraordinary session is vetoed or partially vetoed." ✓
