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

As you know, Finance completely restored the Direct Medical Education piece of GME, but eliminated Indirect Medical Education. We would like to move a small amount of money from DME into IME in order to preserve that piece of the program for the future. (See below)

> After some discussion with our members, we would like to pursue the following technical change to GME, rather than the version I e-mailed to you the other day. The dollar impact (FED and GPR) is exactly the same, we are just moving \$2 million from DME and into IME. The JFC bill keeps all the money in DME, and puts nothing in IME. John said he was fine with this.

SHIFT FROM DME TO IME

> \$17.4 million (all funds) for DME and \$2 million (all funds) for IME. IME will be paid to each hospital based upon its prorata share of what it was paid for IME in 2002 as a proportion of the \$2 million. The IME payments will be subtracted from what each hospital would have otherwise received under the all-DME scenario.
