Here is a text description of the technical amendment related to autism.



Intensive, In-Home Autism Services. This amendment would clarify provisions in current law, that the administering agency for the waivers to redesign of the children's long-term care system could include a human services agency under contract with the Department of Health and Family Services, in addition to county departments. It would specify that the administering agency in counties in which the program is located, rather than county departments, would provide, contract for the provision of, organize, or arrange for the long-term care needs of eligible children. In addition, delete current provisions that would specify that the cost of the children's long-term care program may not exceed the cost of existing community-based waiver programs, the family support program, and the birth-to-three program and delete the provision to blend the costs per child served in these programs.
