

Please draft an amendment for me to do the following:

- 1. Delete the three new appropriations for commuter rail transit system development and, instead, amend the current appropriations under ss. 20.395(2)(ct), (cu) and (cx) to also fund grants under s. 85.064. Provide \$400,000 in 2003-04 in s. 20.395(2)(ct) for the purposes of s. 85.064.
- 2. Delete the new appropriation under s. 20.395(2)(fg) for traffic marking enhancements. Instead, amend s. 20.395(2)(eq) to read "the amounts in the schedule <u>and all moneys transferred from the appropriation account under s. 20.395(3)(cq) as required by 2003 Wisconsin Act (this act), section 9153(4q)". Add s. 85.027 to the allowable uses of the funds, capped at the amounts transferred.</u>
- Delete the new appropriation under s. 20.395(4)(as) for the motorcycle safety program. Instead, retain the current law language funding this program from s. 20.395(4)(aq). Increase funding for s. 20.395(4)(aq) by \$589,300 in 2003-04 and by \$589,300 in 2004-05 to reflect this change.
