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

2. Restore the youth apprenticeship and youth apprenticeship training grant programs to the funding level offered in the Governor's budget. In addition, eliminate the language added by Joint Finance, which creates additional requirements for local programs as well as local businesses. (Comparative Summary page 708-711) Eliminate the mental health drug prior authorization exemption under MA (\$2 million) and the gun hot line (\$100,000) to pay for the GPR we're restoring for the Youth Apprenticeship Program.

1. Allow a school district to raise their levy limit by a simply majority vote of the members of the school board, eliminating the need to go to a referendum.

2. School Finance Commission - JFC motion 715 (6/3/03): amend to include reviewing the WI Choice program, its cost, effectiveness and accountability for student performance; and to analyze the fiscal implications for the public schools in diverting taxpayer dollars for private education.

3. School Choice Appropriation - JFC motion 715 (6/3/03): reinstate the funding level at previous year appropriated amounts for all choice programs and increase funding for MPS. Net effect would be a zero fiscal effect. Increase GPR expenditures by \$686,900 in 2003-04 and \$459,400 in 2004-05 for MPS; a corresponding amount would be cut in the MPCP enrollment to accomplish the net zero effect.

4. Revenue Limit Per Pupil Adjustment - LFB Summary - Page 511, Item 5: restore per-pupil revenue limit expansion as in the governor's budget back to \$236 and \$241 rather than the JFC recommendation of \$120 and \$100. This is what we wanted to do with the restoring of Governor's School Aid Formula from my first email.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 211, line 15: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003-04 by
3 \$750,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004-05 by \$750,000 to
4 increase funding for literacy grants.

5 **2.** Page 510, line 4: delete lines 4 to 11 and substitute:

6 "49.169 (2) The department shall award not more than ~~\$1,404,100~~ \$750,000
7 per fiscal year in grants to qualified applicants for the provision of literacy training
8 to individuals who are eligible for temporary assistance for needy families under 42
9 USC 601 ~~et. et~~ seq."

10 **3.** Page 513, line 10: delete that line and substitute:

11 "SECTION 1270c. 49.175 (1) (y) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 49.175 (1) (y) *Literacy initiative grants*. For literacy grants under s. 49.169 and
2 literacy services administered by the governor's office, \$1,425,800, \$750,000 in fiscal
3 year 2001-02 2003-04 and \$800,000 \$750,000 in fiscal year 2002-03 2004-05."
