Assuming in both scenarios that A1 is adopted, here's my fiscal effect:

Current Law: You would need to add back an additional \$135,100 GPR (\$21,000 under B and \$114,100 under C).

Governor: You would need to add back an additional \$84,800 GPR (\$5,900 under B and \$78,900 under C).

20.435(4)(e) would need to be increased by these amounts.
