Pam,

Based on Milwaukee County having 81.9% of the W-2 cash payment caseload and a program similar to the one proposed by the Gov., we would estimate that the EITC appropriation (20.835(2)(f)) would need to be increased by \$900,900 GPR in 2004-05 and the homestead tax credit appropriation (20.835(2)(c)) would need to be increased by \$982,800 GPR in 2004-05.

I just got an amendment request related to the original budget proposal for creating the transitional subsidized private sector job position in W-2. For a number of reasons, we agreed that I would simply draft a nonstat that would require DWD to create and implement this new type of employment position, rather than actually incorporating everything from the original budget into an amendment. The new position should be implemented on January 1, 2004, as before, but it would be a 4-year pilot in Milwaukee County only. Would I need to make any changes to appropriation amounts? Does the earned income tax credit require anything special? Thanks.

4 **49.1471 Transitional subsidized private sector jobs. (1) PROGRAM**

5 CREATION AND FEATURES. The department shall create and implement, by January 1,

6 2004, a transitional subsidized private sector job program that includes the following

7 features:

8 (a) The program is limited to Milwaukee County.

9 (b) An individual who is eligible for a transitional subsidized private sector job

10 under the program satisfies eligibility criteria specified by the department.

1 (c) An employer that provides a transitional subsidized private sector job
2 satisfies eligibility criteria specified by the department.

3 (d) An individual employed in a transitional subsidized private sector job
4 performs useful work for ~~the~~ employer, is paid by the employer, and may be eligible

6 (e) The department specifies any time limitations that apply to participation
7 in a transitional subsidized private sector job.

8 (f) An individual employed in a transitional subsidized private sector job may
9 be required to search for unsubsidized employment during his or her participation.

10 (g) The department may provide for education or training activities in which
11 an individual employed in a transitional subsidized private sector job may
12 participate.

13 (h) The department may include any other features that the department
14 determines will promote successful participation in unsubsidized employment by
15 individuals employed in transitional subsidized private sector jobs.

16 (2) EVALUATION AND REPORT. ✓ On or before December 31, 2008, the department
17 shall evaluate, and submit a report on, the program created under sub. ✓(1) to the
18 legislature under s. 13.172 (2) ✓ and to the governor. The report shall include an
19 evaluation of the program's effectiveness in enabling individuals employed under the
20 program to obtain and successfully participate in jobs in the private labor market.".
