7	is indigent if the individual satisfies the financial eligibility requirements for a
8	Wisconsin works group under s. 49.145 (3). The state public defender or the
9	authority making the determination of indigency shall consider any assets or income
10	of the spouse of the person claiming to be indigent as if they were assets of the person,
11	unless the spouse was the victim of a crime allegedly committed by the person.".
12	2. Page 1138, line 2: after that line insert:

"(1w) ELIGIBILITY FOR PUBLIC DEFENDER REPRESENTATION. The treatment of
section 977.07 (2) of the statutes first applies to cases opened on the effective date
of this subsection.".
