## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 50, TO 2003 SENATE BILL 44

June 19, 2003 – Offered by Representative Berceau.

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1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute 2 amendment 1, as follows:

- **1.** Page 171, line 4: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by \$136,800 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004–05 by \$691,600 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
- **2.** Page 171, line 6: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by \$42,400 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004–05 by \$219,000 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
- **3.** Page 171, line 8: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by \$345,100 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004–05 by \$1,725,400 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

- **4.** Page 171, line 10: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by \$92,400 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004–05 by \$462,600 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
- **5.** Page 174, line 15: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by \$750,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004–05 by \$750,000 to increase funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
- **6.** Page 176, line 7: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by \$1,366,700 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004–05 by \$3,848,600 to decrease funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
  - **7.** Page 308, line 11: before that line insert:

**"Section 431c.** 20.395 (4) (ax) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.395 **(4)** (ax) Departmental management and operations, federal funds. All moneys received from the federal government for the administration and management of departmental programs except those programs under subs. (2) (bx) and (dx) and (3) (ix), and for departmental planning and administrative activities including all moneys received as federal aid as authorized by the governor under s. 16.54 to promote highway safety and continue the local traffic safety representatives program and for purposes of s. 85.07 and for activities related to the transportation employment and mobility program under s. 85.24 that are not funded from the appropriation under sub. (1) (bs), (bv), or (bx), and to transfer to the appropriation account under s. 20.505 (1) (z) the amounts in the schedule under s. 20.505 (1) (z) and the amounts specified under 2003 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), section 9153 (5c), for such purposes.".

- **8.** Page 731, line 17: delete "and for each calendar year thereafter" and substitute "and for each calendar year thereafter".
  - **9.** Page 731, line 21: after "\$80,000,000." insert "For aid payable for calendar year 2004, from the appropriation under s. 20.395 (1) (ht), the department shall pay \$58,192,000 to the eligible applicant that pays the local contribution required under par. (b) 1. for an urban mass transit system that has annual operating expenses in excess of \$80,000,000. For aid payable for calendar year 2005 and for each calendar year thereafter, from the appropriation under s. 20.395 (1) (ht), the department shall pay \$59,572,900 to the eligible applicant that pays the local contribution required under par. (b) 1. for an urban mass transit system that has annual operating expenses in excess of \$80,000,000.".
  - **10.** Page 732, line 10: delete "and for each calendar year thereafter" and substitute "and for each calendar year thereafter".
  - 11. Page 732, line 14: after "\$80,000,000." insert "For aid payable for calendar year 2004, from the appropriation under s. 20.395 (1) (hu), the department shall pay \$15,536,600 to the eligible applicant that pays the local contribution required under par. (b) 1. for an urban mass transit system that has annual operating expenses in excess of \$20,000,000 but less than \$80,000,000. For aid payable for calendar year 2005 and for each calendar year thereafter, from the appropriation under s. 20.395 (1) (hu), the department shall pay \$15,908,200 to the eligible applicant that pays the local contribution required under par. (b) 1. for an urban mass transit system that has annual operating expenses in excess of \$20,000,000 but less than \$80,000,000.".
    - **12.** Page 733, line 8: delete "2003, and" and substitute "2003,".
    - **13.** Page 733, line 9: delete "\$21,757,600" and substitute "\$22,304,600".

- **14.** Page 733, line 9: after "2004" insert "<u>. and \$22,883,000 in calendar year</u> 2 2005".
- **15.** Page 734, line 1: delete "2003, and" and substitute "2003,".
- **16.** Page 734, line 2: delete "\$4,925,100" and substitute "\$5,094,800".
- 17. Page 734, line 2: after "2004" insert ", and \$5,292,100 in calendar year
  2005".
  - **18.** Page 1100, line 16: after that line insert:
  - "(5c) Federal Highway aid; transportation planning grants.
  - (a) In fiscal year 2003–04, the department of transportation shall transfer \$3,407,200 from the appropriation account under section 20.395 (4) (ax) of the statutes to the appropriation account under section 20.505 (1) (z) of the statutes if the transfer will not result in the loss or reduction of federal highway aid received by the state. If the transfer under this paragraph would result in the department expending more federal highway aid in fiscal year 2003–04 than the state receives for fiscal year 2003–04, the department shall reduce expenditures from the appropriation account under section 20.395 (3) (bx) of the statutes in an amount equal to the amount by which the transfer under this paragraph would otherwise cause the department's expenditures of federal highway aid in fiscal year 2003–04 to exceed its receipt of federal highway aid for fiscal year 2003–04.
  - (b) In fiscal year 2004–05, the department of transportation shall transfer \$3,582,600 from the appropriation account under section 20.395 (4) (ax) of the statutes to the appropriation account under section 20.505 (1) (z) of the statutes if the transfer will not result in the loss or reduction of federal highway aid received by the state. If the transfer under this paragraph would result in the department

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expending more federal highway aid in fiscal year 2004–05 than the state receives for fiscal year 2004–05, the department shall reduce expenditures from the appropriation account under section 20.395 (3) (bx) of the statutes in an amount equal to the amount by which the transfer under this paragraph would otherwise cause the department's expenditures of federal highway aid in fiscal year 2004–05 to exceed its receipt of federal highway aid for fiscal year 2004–05.".
