In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455 (5) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$31,900 for fiscal year 2001-02 and the dollar amount is decreased by \$45,700 for fiscal year 2002-03 to decrease funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

(9) AWARDS FOR VICTIMS OF CRIMES. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455 (5) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$46,300 for fiscal year 2001-02 and the dollar amount is decreased by \$66,200 for fiscal year 2002-03 to decrease funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

(10) REIMBURSEMENT FOR VICTIM AND WITNESS SERVICES. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455 (5) (c) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$52,400 for fiscal year 2001-02 and the dollar amount is decreased by \$74,900 for fiscal year 2002-03 to decrease funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of justice under section 20.455 (5) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$150,200 for fiscal year 2001-02 to decrease the transfer of certain consumer protection programs, numerous state enforcement activities, and the department's agency made and consumer protection and enforcement and enforcement positions for the department of justice by 2002-03 to decrease funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
