**FISCAL YEAR 2002-03 BUDGET ADJUSTMENT BILL**

**Title:** Increase appropriation authority for Medical Assistance and BadgerCare.

**Purpose of Draft:** The draft would increase the appropriation authority for two appropriations in the Medical Assistance Trust Fund in order to meet increased costs for Medical Assistance and BadgerCare in the 2002-03 fiscal year. The provision should be nonstatutory. The appropriations affected include:

- S. 20.435 (4)(w): increase the appropriation by \$64,402,900 in the 2002-03 fiscal year.
- S. 20.435 (4)(b): decrease the appropriation by \$9,587,000 in the 2002-03 fiscal year.
- S. 20.435 (4)(bc): increase the appropriation by \$9,587,000 in the 2002-03 fiscal year.

X The appropriation language under s. 20.435 (4)(x), *Health care for low-income families*, may need broadening. Current language specifies that this appropriation should be used for purposes as specified in 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 section 9123 (8e). This should either be amended to strike the Act 16 reference, or to add new language that permits the appropriation be used for this purpose of this draft.

**MEDICAL ASSISTANCE ✓**

Under current federal and state law, Medical Assistance (MA) is a federal-state, jointly funded program that provides reimbursement for health care services provided to aged, blind, disabled, and certain other MA recipients, who have few assets and low income. The Badger Care program operates under a waiver of federal MA laws to provide MA health services and benefits to low-income families. Under current law, the MA trust fund consists of federal MA moneys received, based on public funds that are transferred under federal law and used as the nonfederal share of MA funding.

This bill increases funding for MA from the MA trust fund by ~~\$64,000,000~~ in fiscal year 2002-03, decreases general purpose revenue funding for MA by ~~\$2,600,000~~ in fiscal year 2002-03, and increases general purpose revenue funding for Badger Care from the MA trust fund by ~~\$2,600,000~~ in fiscal year 2002-03.
