

2003 SENATE BILL 148

1 **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state
2 of Wisconsin and the Professional Employees in Research, Statistics, and
3 Analysis, WFT/AFT, AFL-CIO, for the 2001-03 biennium, covering employees
4 in the professional research, statistics, and analysis collective bargaining unit,
5 and authorizing an expenditure of funds.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6 **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative
7 agreement negotiated for the 2001-03 biennium between the state of Wisconsin,
8 department of employment relations, and the Professional Employees in Research,
9 Statistics, and Analysis, WFT/AFT, AFL-CIO, covering employees in the
10 professional research, statistics, and analysis collective bargaining unit under

1 subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the
2 professional research, statistics, and analysis collective bargaining unit and
3 approved and recommended by the joint committee on employment relations, and
4 authorizes the necessary expenditure of moneys for implementation from the
5 appropriations made by section 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865
6 (intro.) of the statutes. The secretary of employment relations shall file an official
7 copy of the agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on
8 employment relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement
9 between the parties that is not a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved
10 by the legislature under this act.

11 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

12 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those
13 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement
14 covering employees in the professional research, statistics, and analysis collective
15 bargaining unit are effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
