

2003 SENATE BILL 148

May 5, 2003 – Introduced by JOINT COMMITTEE ON EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state
2 of Wisconsin and the Professional Employees in Research, Statistics, and
3 Analysis, WFT/AFT, AFL-CIO, for the 2001–03 biennium, covering employees
4 in the professional research, statistics, and analysis collective bargaining unit,
5 and authorizing an expenditure of funds.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes. The proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employees in the professional research, statistics, and analysis collective bargaining unit negotiated for the 2001–03 biennium under the State Employment Labor Relations Act. Currently, statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.
