

~~The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:~~

3 SECTION 1. 346.94 (15) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 346.94 (15) TOWING BY BUSES OR HUMAN SERVICE VEHICLES. No person may
5 operate a school bus or a human service vehicle over any public highway of this state
6 with any trailer or semitrailer attached. This subsection does not apply to a school
7 bus that is not required to be registered under ch. 341 and that is registered in
8 another jurisdiction in which the law of that jurisdiction permits the school bus to
9 be operated with a trailer or semitrailer attached.

10 SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

1 (1) This act first applies to violations committed on the effective date of this
2 subsection, but does not preclude the counting of other violations as prior violations
3 for sentencing a person.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may operate within this state a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached. This bill allows a person to enter the state and operate a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached if the school bus is registered in another state and that state's law permits the operation of the school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached.
