Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the State Fair Park Board includes four legislators, two members of the assembly, and two senators. The provision specifying legislative membership is sunset on June 30, 2003. This bill eliminates the sunset on legislative membership on the State Fair Park Board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
