1	department shall encourage private institutions of higher education to accept the
2	vouchers. The vouchers are not transferable.
3	<b>SECTION 9.</b> 115.28 (51) of the statutes is created to read:
4	115.28 (51) Funeral assistants. Encourage school boards to grant an excused
5	absence to a pupil in grades 6 to 12 for the purpose of sounding "Taps" during a
6	military honors funeral for a deceased veteran.
