

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 196**

June 24, 2003 – Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 15: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 3m.** 19.35 (1) (i) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 19.35 (1) (i) Except as authorized under this paragraph and except as provided
5 in s. 19.36 (13), no request under pars. (a) and (b) to (f) may be refused because the
6 person making the request is unwilling to be identified or to state the purpose of the
7 request. Except as authorized under this paragraph, no request under pars. (a) to
8 (f) may be refused because the request is received by mail, unless prepayment of a
9 fee is required under sub. (3) (f). A requester may be required to show acceptable
10 identification whenever the requested record is kept at a private residence or
11 whenever security reasons or federal law or regulations so require.”.
